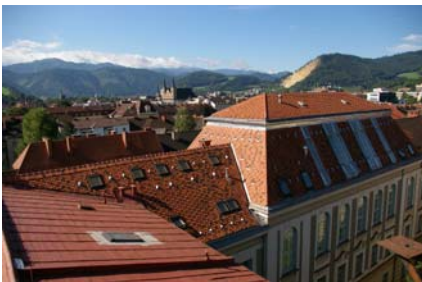

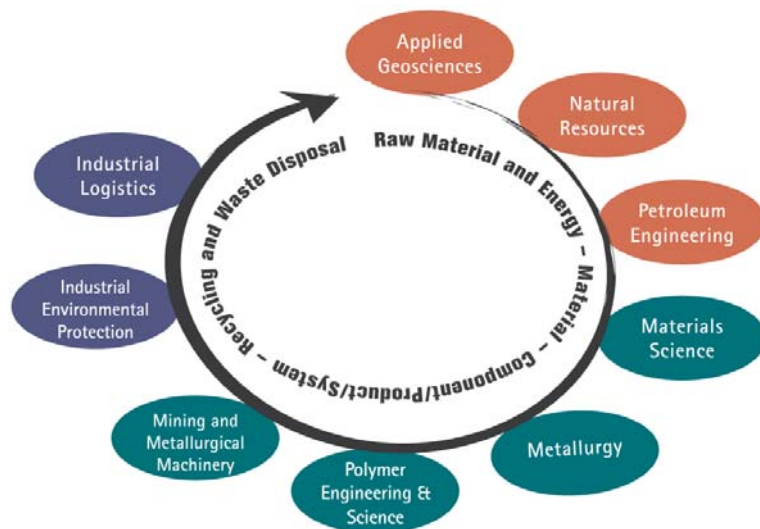

| Health Insurance | All students must pay the Student Union fee (approx. 19 €) which includes accident and liability insurance. If you cannot provide extensive health coverage from your home country you must register for Austrian student health insurance with a monthly fee of about 50 € |

| Is there any bank on campus? | Not on campus but many in the vicinity |
